

What to do if you are SEXUALLY HARASSED

- If a teacher, student, or coach is harassing you, go to the principal. Every school has a policy on sexual harassment. There are laws to protect you whether you are a student, worker, or both.
- Firmly tell the other person to stop the harassment and document (write down) all examples of it and make a list of any witnesses.
- If you find that the school will not help you for some reason, call your local sexual assault crisis center.
- If you see harassing behavior toward someone else, speak up and don't be afraid what anyone will say or think. Protect yourself and help protect others.
